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**ATTACHMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
MISSISSIPPI SCHOLASTIC CHESS ASSOCIATION**

8. Purpose.

A. The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and/or scientific purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as now or hereafter amended, and the regulations thereunder.

B. The Corporation shall not engage (other than as an insubstantial part of its activities) in activities which in themselves are not in furtherance of one or more of its purposes at Subarticle A of this Article 8.

C. The Corporation shall not issue any stock or pay any dividends or other distributions to its members, officers, or directors or to any other private individuals or persons.

10. Inurement of Income.

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof.

11. Legislative or Political Activities.

No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

12. Operational Limits.

Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a Corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

13. Dissolution.

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.
